16 to 19 Tuition Fund Statement 2020-2021

This 'catch up support' funding will be allocated to support the learning and progress of our lower on entry post-16 students, who accessed Mirfield College programmes of study with a grade 4 or lower in either GCSE English or Mathematics (prioritise those with =<grade 3 or SEND.) Funding has been divided amongst a number of tuition strategies including funding the role of a 'Raising Progress Leader' to create and deliver personalised programmes for these students to ensure impact is tailored and tracked. This is in addition to extra GCSE English and Mathematics tuition (online and face-to-face) and Level 3 subject specific intervention to increase progress and achievement. Delivery of support will be personalised and ranges from one-to-one to one-to-three group sessions, with limited occasions of up to one-to-five groups. Impact will be based upon interim internal assessments, staff and student voice, coursework progress and GCSE and Level 3 achievement outcomes (summer 2021).
