OVERVIEW

The BTEC Level 2 in Public Services is designed for learners who have chosen to focus their learning and career development within the public services sector and who are looking for an engaging and stimulating qualification which will prepare them for successful performance in working life and progression by developing a range of essential skills, techniques and attitudes. It is specifically designed for post-16 learners and can be taken as part of a wider Level 2 post-16 study programme. It is an ideal qualification if they are intending to progress directly to employment in the public services sector, or progress to a Level 3 qualification.

GCSE Grade 3 in English Language/Literature and GCSE Grade 3 in Mathematics

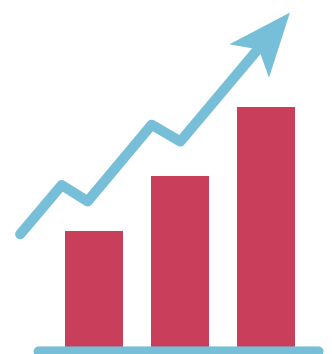
ASSESSMENT
