

Wild Activities Challenging Kirklees Young People 'Winter WACKY 2024/25'



Information & Booking Form

WACKY offers a packed programme of activities for young people with disabilities aged 10 - 24 to take part in over the holidays. Projects will be based at Little Deer Wood Activity Centre Shepley Bridge Marina, Huddersfield Road, Mirfield. WF14 9HR. Activities will run on Monday 23rd December, Tuesday 24th December, Thursday 2nd January and Friday 3rd January 2025 from 10.30am – 3.30pm. There will be an opportunity to choose from different activities each day.

The activities on offer may include arts, woodwork crafts, baking, circus skills, digital photography, and music. The more energetic amongst you will enjoy a choice of sporting activities which could include, bouldering, bush craft or archery.

Please come dressed for activities and the season with suitable clothing, footwear and a waterproof jacket, which should prepare you for our varied British weather. To get a flavour of previous WACKY programmes a film can be viewed on www.kirkleesdofe.org/wacky.

WACKY is an activity programme and we welcome all young people with a disability, however we do not have staff to provide one to one, or two to one support. We would encourage you to come along with your personal assistant/carer if required; this has been the case over many years and has worked well. If you are new to WACKY a member of staff will contact you, after receiving your booking form, to discuss your child's needs further and arrange a pre-visit if necessary.

The meeting point for drop off and pick up each day will be at St Paul's Church, Newgate, Mirfield WF14 8DD (please see next page for more directions). Those who require accessible parking can go straight to Shepley Bridge Marina, please let us know if this is required in advance.

The cost of the sessions will be £15 per person per day, this price is subsidised. Each day, we will provide a hot lunch for the children. However, if your child prefers to bring their own packed lunch, they are more than welcome to do so. Please indicate this on the booking form. In all cases, please complete the dietary needs on the booking form.

To book your place please complete and return the attached registration form, either by email or via the QR Code. We have limited capacity per age group so to avoid disappointment a prompt reply is advised. It is recommended that you keep a note of all the dates you have booked to avoid any confusion.


Little Deer Wood Activity Centre

Shepley Bridge Marina is on the A644 (Huddersfield Road).

The 203 bus, from Huddersfield Bus Station Stand Y or 262 bus from Dewsbury Bus Station stand 14.

Meeting point for drop off and pick up each day will be St Paul's Church, Newgate, Mirfield WF14 8DD (see below). You will be met by our staff and transported to Little Deer Wood Activity Centre.



The church is accessed from Newgate, if coming on Huddersfield Road turn down the road towards the canal by Speights Lighting shop. Please park around the back of the church where there are 2 car parks. If you can please drive up the ramp and park on the top car park as it will allow us to turn the bus around on the bottom car park. If the top car park is full please park as near to it as you can.
